- Rule 1: Noise -

From 10:00pm, participants must reduce noise on the premises of JUFA – Schladming (including the rooms), except for the hotel bar. Any forms of loud music, speaking, stomping, etc. are strictly prohibited from that time until the next morning. Gatherings are allowed to take place off the premises.

- Rule 2: Substances -

The consumption of any form of illicit substances on the premises of JUFA – Schladming is strictly prohibited. Cigarettes/Vapes are to be consumed outdoors.

- Rule 3: Alcohol -

The consumption of alcohol is generally allowed on the premises of JUFA – Schladming. Bringing alcoholic beverages to restricted areas, such as the sauna, however, is strictly prohibited. Further, the consumption of alcohol as well as party gatherings in the hotel lobby and other public areas in the hotel are to be refrained from.

- Rule 4: Property Damage & Waste -

Any damage to the property of JUFA – Schladming is to be reported immediately by the person responsible at reception. Waste generated must be disposed of independently. Deliberate destruction of property will immediately result in exclusion from future events organized by SIMConnect.
